# RS Feva Grand Prix

## RULES, RESPONSIBILITIES AND DISCLAIMERS

### Rules and Responsibilities

#### Entry Criteria

All competitors must be members of the RS Feva Class Association

#### Entering

Entries will close at noon on Monday 23<sup>rd</sup> June 2008. Late entries will not be accepted.

#### Insurance

Valid and current third party liability insurance, which covers competitors for third party claims whilst sailing and racing, for not less than £2,000,000 must be held for the duration of the event.

#### Car Park

This is located in West Mersea marine a short distance from the Club. Please make sure you display the sticker provided and park in a tidy manner. The £5 charge is for the weekend.

#### Medical

All competitors should declare any medical conditions and/or allergies, providing the organisers with all relevant information. Medical details will be treated as confidential.

#### Signing On

All competitors must sign on before each racing session and sign off immediately after each racing session

#### Decision to Race

We point you towards the International Racing Rules of Sailing [www.sailing.org/RRS2005](http://www.sailing.org/RRS2005). In particular, please make yourself aware of Fundamental Rule 4 regarding the responsibilities associated with deciding whether or not to go afloat.

#### Launch and Recovery

Competitors will launch in fleets and be escorted to and from the race area by a team of safety and support boats. No one may launch without the permission of the beach master. The launching and retrieval process, whilst managed by the beach master, is the responsibility of competitors.

#### Buoyancy Aids/Lifejackets

All competitors must wear an adequate buoyancy aid or lifejacket that is properly fastened whilst on the water. These aids must remain visible at all times to the safety boats whilst on the water.

#### Racing

The organisers reserve the right to change the published times of racing, to postpone or cancel racing at any time. All racing will generally take place either in the Mersea Creeks or the River Blackwater

#### Sail Numbers

All competitor's sails must carry an identification number. Sail numbers must be entered on the Entry Form. Any changes to individual entrants sail numbers during the event must be notified to the Race Officer, Safety Officer and Shore Control.

#### Safety on the Water

All competitors must obey any instructions they are given by the beach master, event safety and support boat crews, and the race committee. All competitors must keep clear of moored boats, moving deep draft vessels and busy channels. In the event of a collision it is the competitor's responsibility to tell his/her parents and the parent's responsibility to inform the owner. be presented at the organiser's discretion.

#### Catering

Food will be available for all competitors and parents at the Dabchicks sailing club galley. This will be open from 8.00am each morning.

#### Social Activities

After racing on Saturday there will be a family BBQ at the club commencing at 6pm

#### Photography and video

Photographs may be taken during this event, stored and reproduced for the purpose of promotion and publicity, for use on the appropriate websites and for distribution to the event participants.

Any entrants or their parents/guardians who have any concerns or objections should write to the organising committee.

#### The Waterfront

Bins are provided for all litter. Competitors may be asked to tidy the area between the two clubs.

The waterfront is a residential area and the property and privacy of the neighborhood must be respected at all times. All involved with the event are asked to keep noise levels to a minimum, especially after dark.

## **Disclaimers**

It is for each individual competitor to decide whether he/she is fit to sail in the conditions in which he/she will find themselves. By launching or going to sea, the person confirms that he/she is fit for those conditions and his/her crew is competent to sail and compete in them.

Each participating boat is required to hold adequate insurance and in particular to hold valid insurance against third party claims in the sum of £2,000,000 or the equivalent.

It is acknowledged that each competitor who submits an entry form or for whom an entry form is submitted is deemed to be fit and healthy enough to participate in all Event activities. Any entrant with a medical condition and/or serious allergy, should declare the condition and all relevant information to the Event organisers. In so doing, the entrant is deemed to be giving consent for any necessary medical treatment.

Nothing done by the organisers can reduce the responsibility of the competitor nor will it make the organisers responsible for any loss, damage, death or personal injury, however it may have occurred, as a result of the boat taking part in the event. The organisers encompass everyone helping to run the Event and include, among others, the Organising Authority, the race committee, the race officer, safety and support crews, coaches, shore and social teams.
